COVID -19 ENHANCED HEALTH AND SAFETY PRACTICES

During this time of enhanced concern Kiddie Koop Children's Enrichment Center is continuing to stay up-to-date with the latest state and local guidelines, licensing requirements, and guidelines of the CDC regarding the health, safety and well being of your child and our staff. Kiddie Koop Children's Enrichment Center has exceeded these guidelines by taking the following measures:

1. We have installed Auto-Cleaning NeedlepointBipolar Ionization Systems in all classrooms which allow:
 - Particle Reduction
 - Neutralizing Odors by destroying VOCs
 - Pathogens Killed (Bacteria, Viruses, Mold), Helps to Control Allergens/Asthma
2. We are limiting the people who can enter the building to staff, children and regulatory agencies.
3. Temperature checks for all children and staff who enter the building and throughout the day.
4. External drop-off and pick-up of children.
5. Increased frequency of hand washing and use of hand sanitizer by children over the age of 2 years and staff.
6. Wearing of mask requirement for staff and school age children except when eating or drinking.
7. Refraining from letting children use family style serving during meals.
8. Limiting sensory activities to individual sensory activity instead of group sensory play.
9. Increased sanitation of frequently touched surfaces and toys.
10. Offering virtual tours of the center to eliminate the risk of someone coming into the center with possible illnesses.
